Happy New Year to you all.

It's amazing how much there is to get done when you're doing what needs to be done. Apparently, ignoring it all doesn't actually make it go away... In trying to file as a nonprofit recreation club [501 (c)(7)] so we can change our meeting venue to cut costs and add convenience, I learned we were no longer a corporation because we hadn't submitted paperwork since 2009. So I applied to have us reinstated. Then I learned we didn't have an EIN--basically a tax ID--necessary for a 501 (c)(7), so I applied for one of those. Then I learned we were also delinquent with the State Franchise Tax Board. More fun. Suffice it to say, as of this writing--many government forms and scads of paperwork later--we have paid most all fees and fines, we are a California corporation with an EIN, and the federal government regards us as a nonprofit, as soon as we file with the IRS *back to 1955*. But since the Franchise Tax Board acknowledged we were working to get clear, it also sent a fax saying we were indeed a nonprofit. Yay! So we're moving to Zamperini Field (Torrance Airport) starting in **February**! The address is 3301 Airport Drive, just north of PCH, on Zamperini Way. Head for the control tower and hang a left.

I can't begin to say how wonderful it was that nearly 65 members put in about 200 hours of labor to paint the benches and posts, fix what needed fixing, and build new carpet butts. The place looks awesome!

The new gate signs are up. Please make sure you flip them so it's red if you're using the range, white if no one's there, and if it's yellow and you're not helping at a work party, please stay off the road.

We're looking for an Entertainment Chair who will make sure there's refreshments at the start of each monthly membership meeting and ALSO water at each monthly tournament. It's a very easy task if you already show up these 24 times.

When signing up/renewing in February, please remember we also need the insurance waiver filled out for every family member who will be shooting. We're doing it ONCE, no longer at individual tournaments. This includes 3Ds. Since we expanded the explanation of "rules," when you sign the application--and this includes all renewing members--you're both acknowledging and agreeing to follow said 'rules'.

All the numerous items that came up at the meeting will hopefully be reflected in the minutes. Worth repeating are the Constitutional Amendments to make official both the positions of Range Captain and 3-D Chairperson. Their existence--the positions--will be voted on in April.

I sincerely hope as many members as can make it come to our annual banquet at China Buffet on Saturday, January 28th. Good food, great people, at a bargain price.
